

Selection Criteria for the 18th FINA World Championships

12 – 28 July 2019 – Gwangju, Korea

a. Qualification Times:-

- Any swimmer who has already qualified can submit their times swum from 1st March 2018 to 8th June 2019.
- Any swimmer who has already swum the above time but not achieved it at FINA sanctioned meet may swim a FINA meet and submit times to FINA to be recognized as qualified swimmer

b. Selection procedure:-

- A total of Four (4) swimmers will be selected to represent Sri Lanka this championship
 - No swimmer qualified: two (2) men and two (2) women;
 - One (1) or two (2) swimmers qualified, additional swimmers up to a maximum of four (4) swimmers will be selected - two (2) men and two (2) women
 - Three (3) swimmers qualified one (1) additional swimmer provided that both genders are represented
- A swimmer may enter up to a total of 5 events
- Each event will only have one (1) competitor from each country unless both swimmers requesting for the same event has achieved a **"A Standard Qualification"** at a FINA sanctioned championship

- iv. A trial for selections will be held on the 8th & 9th of June at the Sugathadasa Stadium for all swimmers training locally. Past times from long course performances from the 1st of November 2019 up to the 8th of June 2019 can be submitted to the SLASU at the end of the Trial (9th June) if you have swum a faster time
- v. Swimmers training overseas – Such swimmer can submit times for selections from performances of any FINA recognized Long Course Championships between 1st January 2019 to 7th June 2019 provided that they are NATIONAL RECORD HOLDERS. Such times should be submitted to the SLASU office via email by the 7th of June by 4.00pm
- vi. Any swimmer who trains abroad but not holding a National Record, such swimmers need to participate for the Selection Trial
- vii. Selections will be done by the scoring of FINA points
- viii. The two highest FINA points scorers will be selected per gender. No two swimmers from the same event will be selected.
- ix. In an event where a swimmer withdraws from an event, the next best swimmer will not be selected.
- x. Matthey Duncan Abeysinghe has already been recognized by FINA as he has Achieved the “B Qualification Standard” in the 50m, 100m & 200m Freestyle. Hence, we won’t be selecting any other swimmer scoring high FINA points from these events unless any swimmer swims faster and achieved a higher qualification at a FINA Sanctioned Championships than what has already been swum by Matthew Abeysinghe.
 - 50m Freestyle - 22.65 - Commonwealth Games Gold Coast - 9th April 2018
 - 100m Freestyle - 49.11 - Commonwealth Games Gold Coast 7th April 2018
 - 200m Freestyle – 1:50.97 – Asian Games Jakarta, Indonesia 19th August 2019
- xi. In a situation where FINA points scored are equal swum in 2 different events by 2 athletes. SLASU holds the right to select one swimmer based on ranking prospects of the competition

Rules & Procedures:-

1. All swimmers taking part for this selection trial should be registered athletes under SLASU for the year 2019

2. All event will be swum as TIMED FINALS

4. A swimmer may enter as much event as desired provided that they have achieved a least of ONE qualification times from above table
5. A swimmer who has only made ONE or TWO qualifications but wanting to swim more events can enter as NT for such unqualified events in their respective entry form
6. Swimmer must state their entry times in their entry forms which should also clearly mention the name of meet and year of the meet which the entry time was achieved. swimmers providing false timings will be disqualified.
7. performance from Long Course Championships held between 1st January 2017 to 7th June 2019 can be used for entering purposes for this selection trial

8. Instruction for the filling of the Entry Form:-

- a. Enter the best time for relevant events. If you enter a wrong time the Jury has the right to take decisions.
- b. The entry of the Date of Birth is compulsory.
- c. Please make sure to attach the duly complete form should be sent separately for boys & girls.
- d. All entries should be duly signed by the Principal/President/Secretary and School/Club seal on all entry forms.

9. Rules of the Meet

- a. The meet will be conducted under the laws of FINA and the Rules of the SLASU. The ONE START Rule will apply.
- b. Any swimmer who violates this rule will be disqualified
- c. The entry fee per event of the selection trial is Rs. 1,000/- (rupees one thousand) only.
- d. **All entries for selection trial must be submitted to SLASU Office on or before 04th JUNE 2019 – 4:00 pm.**
