1. Declaration:

I hereby declare that;

- I am the above-named and I AM / I AM NON-SRI LANKAN CITIZEN.
- I am presently a student/member of the above declared school/club.
- I have provided my consent to represent the above school/club or to be registered as an UNATTACHED athlete as mentioned above.
- The details provided herein is true and correct.
- I will keep my address and all other personal information up to date with my school, club and notify the Sri Lanka Aquatic Sports Union (SLASU) immediately in writing of any changes.
- I understand that upon payment of my registration fee (if any) I will become a registered athlete of SLASU and that by payment of such fee each year by the due date either through my school, club or as an unattached athlete, I will continue to be a registered athlete, unless I inform SLASU or my registration is suspended or terminated.
- I agree to act and abide by all that is stated herein this document unconditionally.
- I agree to abide by the findings, directives or ruling of any disciplinary proceedings conducted by SLASU in the event any disciplinary proceeding brought against me.

2. Rules:

As a registered athlete I will;

- abide by the Sports Law Act No. 25 of 1973, its regulations and other laws, as revised and updated from time to time, that may be applicable as sports person in the practice of any sport as a registered athlete of SLASU.

- abide by the constitution, regulations, policies, manuals, guidelines and reasonable direction of the school, club, SLASU, the National Olympic Committee of Sri Lanka and FINA respectively.
- abide by the Code of Conduct unconditionally issued by SLASU.
- comply with the Convention Against Doping in Sport Act No. 33 of 2013, as revised and updated from time to time, and the anti-doping policies of SLASU, the Sri Lanka Anti-Doping Agency, World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) and their assigns and commit to a drug free sport and the practice of it.

3. Termination:

I understand;

- I may terminate my registration with immediate effect by giving notice at any time.
- I will lose my status as a registered athlete and may be suspended or terminated if I change my sports nationality by representing a National Federation of another country.
- that my school/club may request to suspend or terminate my registration due to disciplinary action or leaving the respective school or club.

4. Code of Conduct:

As a registered athlete I agree and confirm to abide and act by the Code of Conduct below and common ethical principles as an individual.

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others.
- Be fair, considerate and honest in all dealings with others.
- Be professional in, and accept responsibility for, my actions.

- d) Be aware of, and maintain an uncompromising adherence to, standards, rules, regulations and policies.
- e) Understand the possible consequences of breaching the SLASU Code of Conduct and its rules.
- f) Immediately report any breaches of other SLASU registered athletes to the appropriate authority.
- g) Refrain from any form of abuse, harassment, discrimination, or victimization towards others.
- h) Co-operate to provide a safe environment for the conduct of the activity in accordance with relevant SLASU policy.
- i) Co-operate to participate in any doping tests random or otherwise by any authorized body to SLASU is affiliated to by its activities.
- j) Show concern and caution towards others who may be sick or injured.
- k) Be a positive role model as a sports person.
- l) To abide by decisions of the referee, jury of appeal and the SLASU at competitions.
- m) To abide by the rules of the circular/summons for competitions/any activity convened by SLASU its affiliates or higher authoritative bodies.
- n) To not provide comment to any media on behalf of the Sri Lanka Aquatic Sports Union (SLASU) and/or other affiliated institutions unless authorized.
- o) In the event of any grievance or dispute, to not speak to any media and/or comment in any social platform, personal or otherwise, in a negative way regarding the Sri Lanka Aquatic Sports Union (SLASU) without reason, or having made first-representation and/or giving opportunity of a right of response, and/or reasonable period of time to respond.
- p) Never act in any way that may bring disrepute or disgrace to SLASU, its stakeholders and/or its sponsors, potential sponsors and/or partners.
- q) Never argue with or verbally abuse an official. Always use the appropriate rules and guidelines to resolve a dispute.
- r) Not participate (or benefit from assisting others involved) in sports betting or gambling activity associated with aquatic events and/or results in which they are participating or have been directly involved in.
- s) Conduct yourself in a sportsman-like manner and respect fellow swimmers, coaches, managers, staff, officials and the achievement of opponents.

- t) Refraining from bullying or taking an unfair advantage of another competitor.
- u) Refrain from possessing, consuming prohibited substances while in SLASU camps or on tours.
- v) Refrain from consuming or purchasing alcohol and tobacco while in SLASU camps or on tours without the agreement of the Team Manager and Head Coach.
- w) Comply with attire, training, competition, curfew and behaviour requirements directed by SLASU, while in camp or on tours.

5. Disciplinary Proceedings

I understand that;

- a) Disciplinary proceedings may be brought against me for breach of any of the contents stated herein, rules or actions by me arising from them or other related authorities by way of affiliation.
- b) My registration may be suspended until such disciplinary proceedings are completed.

6. Selections for Competitions, Training or Other Activity representing SLASU and/or Sri Lanka

I agree to;

- a) Follow the criteria and rules laid out generally and specifically for selection for competitions, training or any other activity representing SLASU and/or Sri Lanka.
- b) Abide by the decisions of the Selection Committee for Aquatic Sports and higher authorities in all matters regarding selections for competitions.
- c) To resolve any disputes by making representations first and directly to the convening body or organizer.
- d) To resolve any disputes, post appeal by arbitration as governed by the Arbitration Act, No. 11 of 1995 and/or any amendments that may be made.

7. Right to first Hearing of Complaint or Grievance and Right to first Response

As a registered athlete, I hereby undertake to;

- a) Provide the right to the first hearing of any complaint or grievance by addressing such matters directly to SLASU in writing at the first instance.
- b) Provide SLASU a reasonable period of time to respond, before addressing any such matters to higher authorities.
